# *Nebraska City: Red To The Core*

**Wednesday & Thursday, Sept. 9 & 10, 2020**

**Day 1 – Wednesday, Sept. 9** - Embark on a fun-filled two-day getaway and experience the allure of Nebraska City. Our first stop will be at the Lied Lodge & Conference Center where you will learn about this magnificent facility and its tree-planting mission. Today's included lunch will be at the Keeping Room, a very popular food spot that combines stylish antiques and unique fashions with fabulous food and homemade desserts, all in a historic 1870s building.

Plan on climbing aboard a full sized replica of the keelboat used 200 years ago by the Lewis & Clark expedition on their remarkable journey up the Missouri River. Then feel the strength it took to row such a boat. Your visit to the Lewis & Clark Interpretive Center will include a must-see documentary film followed by a tour of a life sized replica of a Native American Earth Lodge, complete with flowers on top.

The little child in you will certainly come to life while walking amongst the tree houses at Arbor Day Farm. And the fun will continue with a wagon ride through the forest where you will learn about the impressive orchards that bear fruit throughout the season.

Following an included dinner in the beautiful Timber Dining Room, the day will end at the fire pit with Sunset & S'mores.

**Day 2 – Thursday, Sept. 10** - A trip to Nebraska City wouldn't be complete without a visit to Arbor Lodge State Park. Besides the wooded rolling hills, the main attraction is the 52-room Arbor Lodge mansion, home of J. Sterling Morton, who was the founder of Arbor Day. Docents dressed in period costume will take you on a guided tour of this lovely White House look-alike. Make sure you explore the grounds and visit the carriage house, complete with its many early carriages.

A fun and educational experience awaits you at Kimmel Orchard & Vineyard, where apples, cherries, grapes and peaches ripen each year. See how apple cider was made yesteryear and take a hayrack ride through the groves, all prior to enjoying an included lunch.

The day will end at the Kregel Windmill Factory Museum where you will step into a time-capsule featuring the original shop used for crafting early 1900s modern technology.
